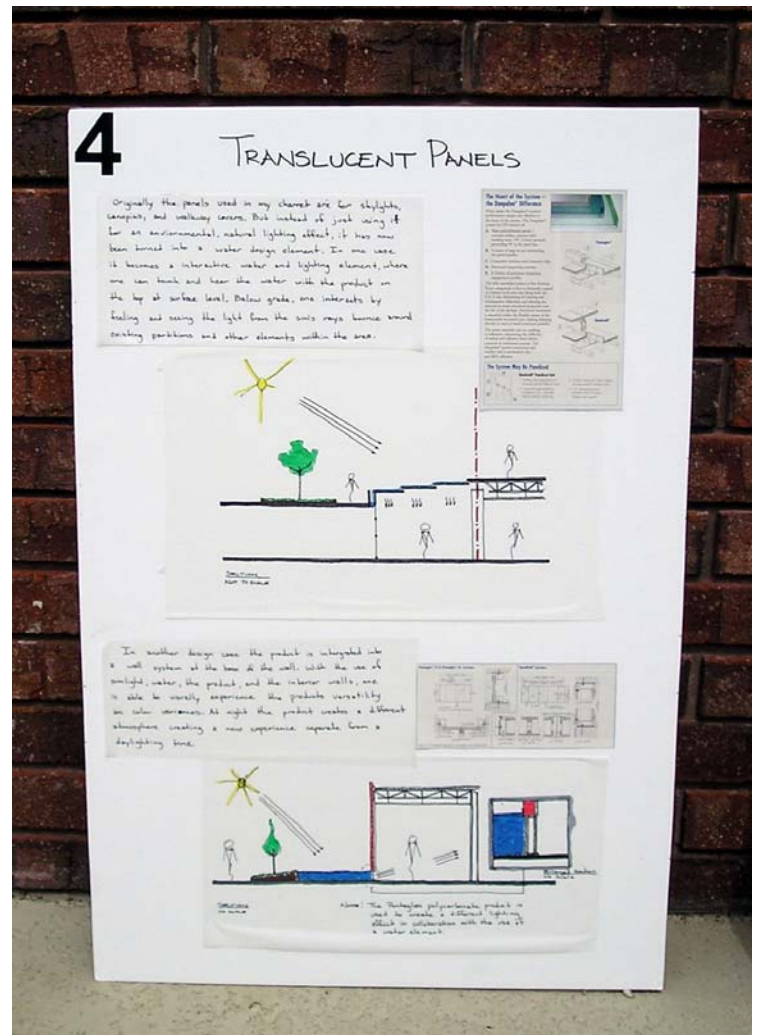


CPI Daylighting appreciates Student Input at Regional CSI Products show in Dallas
